Fair Lawn is proud to have more parks per resident than many other communities. We continue to work with our professionals to determine the upgrades needed in our parks and fields and, in the Spring of 2019, we will unveil a new, upgraded facility at Center Rec Field (located by the High School) that will allow more sports programs to utilize this space.

January 1st will be the start date for the new Volunteer Emergency Services Stipend. ## Sign up for alerts from the Office of Emergency Management

The Borough of Fair Lawn Office of Emergency Management is utilizing a new communications service that allows for important and valuable community information to be sent to residents using the latest technology. The Nixle Community Information Service allows us to create and publish messages to be delivered to subscribed residents instantly via cell phone text message and/or email. The service is secure, reliable and easy to use for our group. Residents of Fair Lawn can immediately begin receiving pertinent information via text message, email, and web by registering at [www.nixle.com](http://www.nixle.com).

## Telephone Notification Registration

Another updated service is the Borough's telephone notification system. **Code Red** is the new telephone notification provider for the emergency notifications. This system, combined with our other emergency alert methods, is designed to get emergency messages to you the public, quickly and effectively. This does not preclude you from calling 911 if you need emergency information; it simply provides an opportunity for us to disseminate critical information to you if and when the need arises. The reason for this form is to gather as many means of contact as you may have, so that in the event of an emergency that affects Fair Lawn, we can notify you in multiple ways. 

## **Recycling & Sanitation**

### **Report Litter Bugs and Become a Litter Marshal!**

Have you seen someone throwing litter from their car either driving or parked someplace? Did you know that you can report the vehicle anonymously? The owner of the vehicle will be notified by mail about the violation! All you have to do is call 201-794-5341, 24 hours per day. We'll need their license plate number, including state, the date, time, location and what was littered. Help keep Fair Lawn clean as we root out those who are making it a mess! If you'd like to become a litter marshal and get a lapel pin, reporting pad and some other items just call the Recycling Office at 201-794-5341. Make a positive difference in Fair Lawn and become a part of this award winning team!

### **Decals Available – Paper & Bottle Collection**

The Recycling Division requires sturdy containers placed at the curb for recycling collection to display decals to denote the commodity in the barrel. Decals are denoted as blue decals for paper and cardboard, red decals for bottles & cans. Decals are available free of charge at the Recycling Office at 20-05 Saddle River Road. Residents may also e-mail their address and which decals they want to be mailed to [recycling@fairlawn.org](mailto:recycling@fairlawn.org) or call 201-794-5341 to have them mailed.

### **Furniture**

Residents are permitted one bulk item (furniture) each garbage day. No appointments necessary.

### **Metal / Electronics**

The Recycling Division accepts metal and electronics at the recycling center and will collect it at the curb with an appointment. Call 201-794-5341 to schedule an appointment. Metal items must be at least 50% metal for us to collect them under this program. Electronics include televisions (not projection or console, which are garbage), computers, monitors, stereos (not speakers), vcrs, dvd players, cell phones, iPads, iPods and other electronic equipment. Just because it has a power cord does not make it electronic.

## Outdoor Pesticide Application

Pesticides must be used according to label direction under penalty of EPA law. Large quantity, outdoor spray applications of pesticides require neighbor notifications. Homeowners using lawn services or contractors for pest and weed control must ensure that the service is licensed with the State and has a Fair Lawn Health Department registration. ## The Office of Fire Prevention

The mission of the Fair Lawn Fire Prevention Bureau is to prevent fires. Each year, approximately 4,500 locations are subject to Fire Safety Inspections conducted by the Bureau in accordance with the New Jersey Uniform Fire Code. Additionally, the Bureau investigates fires and various other incidents, and coordinates with Law Enforcement and other outside agencies as might be necessary. The Bureau also seeks to prevent fires and injury by educating the public in Fire Safety. Where residential properties are concerned, a fire inspection is required prior to sale, rental, or change of occupancy of 1- and 2-family homes. In addition to the existing requirements for these inspections, the N.J. Uniform Fire Code now requires the installation of ten-year sealed battery-powered single station smoke alarms as opposed to battery operated smoke alarms which were previously permitted. Inspections can be scheduled with the Bureau by telephone at (201) 794-5408 or in person. The requirements can be obtained from the Borough website.

## Building and Zoning Department

Warmer weather signals the start of many home improvement projects. As you plan your project it's important that you make sure that you know what permits and approvals you may need before you start working. Starting work without a permit could mean you have to remove some of the interior finishes for required inspections or having to replace a product or material that does not meet the Uniform Construction Code, an expensive prospect in either case.

If you are renovating a kitchen or bathroom, building a deck, putting up a new fence or doing other home improvements, call us to find out what permits you will need. We'll help you streamline the process and tell you what kinds of documentation you should provide with your application. Permits are required for water heaters, boiler or furnace replacements, interior renovations, steps, roofing, siding, chimney relining, decks, sheds, fences, additions, above or in-ground swimming pools, etc. When applying for outside projects such as decks, sheds, fences, additions, pools, etc., you will need to bring a copy of your property survey in addition to your permit applications.

Zoning Permits are required for sheds, fences, patios, replacement or widening of driveways. Please bring a copy of your survey to apply for these items. Zoning Review Permits are required for things like pools, hot tubs, enclosed porches, signs, foyers, roofs over front platforms, decks, accessory structures, signs, garages, additions, dormers, add-a-levels and sunrooms. A Certificate of Continued Occupancy is required for all tenants. Zoning approval is also required for all commercial projects. Blank application forms are now available on Fair Lawn's website. The Fair Lawn Building Department is here to help keep your project safe and code compliant.

Permits are issued between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Homeowners should make sure that contractors receive all the necessary permits before starting any work. Please allow ample time for both Zoning and Building review, and plan accordingly when scheduling your project.

## Fair Lawn Green Fair

The 6th Annual Green Fair will be held at Memorial Middle School on April 10, 2019, 6:00- 8:00pm. The highlight this year will be about water protection. Other topics will include the Tower Garden, hydroponic gardening, include environmental sustainability, solar energy, green roofs, rain barrels, fracking, brownfields, vapor intrusion, safe routes to school initiative, bicycling and an educational farm. Environmental organizations will provide hands on demonstrations and tabletop teaching displays. The Environmental Commission, Green Team, Historic Preservation Commission, Recycling and Clean Communities Division and Environmental Remediation Specialists will be present to answer questions. The Community Garden, Water Ambassadors, Hackensack River Keeper, Garretson Farm, Environmental Clubs from Fair Lawn Schools will also share the experience. The Green Team will offer updates on Fair Lawn's Sustainable New Jersey status.



## Litter Clean Up Days

The Recycling Division will be holding litter clean ups on Saturday April 20<sup>th</sup>, May 18<sup>th</sup>, June 15<sup>th</sup>, and September 14<sup>th</sup> from 8:45 AM to 12:30 PM. Volunteers will be provided with gloves, bags, safety vests and food. Volunteers will meet at the Fair Lawn Recycling Office, 20-05 Saddle River Road at 8:45 AM and the bus will leave promptly at 9:00 AM. This qualifies for community service hours that many schools and religious organizations require. Volunteers must wear long pants and closed toed shoes for the event. Anyone wishing to volunteer must register **five** days prior to the event to assure adequate transportation and supplies. ## Construction Material Collection

The Borough garbage contractor will be collecting small amounts of construction material at the curb during the weeks of May 6<sup>th</sup> and October 21<sup>st</sup> on the regular garbage day. Quantities are limited to four (4) thirty-two gallon barrels not weighing more than 50 pounds each. Excess quantities will not be collected. Materials must be contained or tied for ease of handling by the collection crew. Construction includes building wood, paneling, sheet rock, tiles, toilets, sinks, doors, windows, cabinetry, countertops and garage doors. Construction does NOT include any recyclables (including metal), hazardous materials, paints, brick, block, stone, concrete, asphalt, stone, rocks and dirt. These items will not be collected.

Also, any Veteran who is deemed by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a 100% service connected disability or was a Prisoner of War, should receive a free Memorial Pool membership for themselves and their immediate family (as defined by the Borough's Recreation Department's guidelines).

Also at Memorial Pool, we have placed "Military and Veterans Only Parking" signs at four designated parking spots along the fence line of the pool. We are looking to also place these signs in the parking lots of other Borough owned buildings and parks.



**Project Medicine Drop Box:** Project Medicine Drop allows residents to bring their household medications, 24 hours-a-day 7 days-a-week, to Fair Lawn Borough Hall, 8-01 Fair Lawn Avenue, and drop off unused and expired medications into a secure monitored drop-box that can be found on the main floor, inside the Municipal Building near the Police Department . By disposing of unneeded medications, it allows for proper destruction of those medications so that those same medications do not end up in the hands of people who they are not prescribed or meant for.

## Cat License Renewals



Cat License Renewals are now due. Cats over 6 months must be licensed. Owners must show proof of rabies vaccination good through May 1, 2020 to obtain a one year license. One year license fees are: \$12.00 (spayed/ neutered) or \$15.00 (unspayed/unneutered). There is an added \$10.00 fee for each license obtained after June 30. Residents are urged to get their pet cats and dogs licensed to avoid summonses to Municipal Court. For information on three year licenses or questions, call 201-794-5327.

Pet owners are reminded to clean up fecal waste promptly after their pet defecates on private and public property to prevent a public nuisance.

Feeding of pets should not be done outdoors since they may attract rodents, wildlife, stray cats and insect problems. Feeding of stray cats is prohibited as it promotes exposure to cats that may carry rabies.

Dog owners are reminded that a dog barking longer than 10 minutes is considered a noise disturbance, which can result in a summons to court.

Animal Control will pick up dead animals on private property for a fee of \$55.00 (subject to change) per animal payable to Bergen County Animal Control. For animal complaints contact the Fair Lawn Police Department at 201-796-1400.





## Tax Assessor

### Disabled Veteran Exemptions Available

Veterans that have been deemed to be 100% disabled by the United States Veteran's Administration as the result of a service-connected disability may be entitled to a full property tax exemption. Contact the Tax Assessor for eligibility requirements and application claim forms.

### Senior Citizens, Disabled Persons and Veteran Deductions New Applications

**Only:** Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons who meet certain income requirements are eligible for a tax deduction of \$250. New applicants for a tax deduction should obtain application claim forms from the Tax Assessor's Office, and must be filed by December 31. Proof of income must also be submitted along with your application. A surviving spouse/domestic partner of a deceased senior citizen or disabled person that was receiving the deduction may also be eligible.

Veterans who served during a period of war are also eligible for a tax deduction of \$250.00. New applicants for a tax deduction should obtain application claim forms from the Tax Assessor's Office which must be filed by December 31. A copy of the veteran's honorable discharge Form DD-214 is required for approval. A surviving spouse/domestic partner of a deceased Veteran would also be eligible.

It should be noted that the exemptions and deductions listed above are restricted to owners of residential property only. Owners of either a cooperative or condominium unit are also eligible. ## Office of Emergency Management

### Generator Safety

Downed utility lines, blackouts, snow falls or summer storms can lead to power outages. Many residents are turning to generators as a temporary solution. Please remember the following safety precautions.

- Generators should be used in well ventilated locations outside away from all doors, windows and vent openings.
- New use a generator in an attached garage, even with the door open.
- Place generators so that exhaust fumes can't enter the home through windows, doors or other openings.
- Make sure to install carbon monoxide (CO) alarms in your home.
- Turn off generators and let them cool down before refueling. Never refuel a generator while it is running.
- Store fuel for the generator in a container that is intended for the purpose and is correctly labeled as such and store the containers outside of living areas.

### Flood or Fire Damage - It Could Never Happen To Me

Residents are reminded and encouraged to make sure that they have proper homeowners and/or renter's insurance. Many people have the mentality that "it could never happen to them." The average homeowner is five times more likely to incur flood damage than fire damage. A Homeowner's policy may cover fire, tornado or even earthquake damage, most exclude damage caused by flooding. However, not only are residents in this Borough affected by flooding. Other damage, such as fires, could occur. Renter's in the Borough should carry renters insurance to protect their possessions. Landlords of the apartment have insurance, but it probably only covers the building, not the renter's belongings. All residents should make sure that they have proper coverage, whether they are a homeowner or renter.

### Residential Special Needs

The Borough of Fair Lawn Office of Emergency Management has established a Residential Special Needs Registry for citizens who may require special attention during times of emergency. If you or someone you know is using oxygen in their home, requires a walker to get around, or has any other form of disability, fill out an application. All information is kept confidential and is distributed to the police, fire, rescue, ambulance, health, and public works departments for use during emergency. ### Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)

CERT members give critical support to first responders in emergencies, provide immediate assistance to victims, organize spontaneous volunteers at a disaster site, and collect disaster intelligence to support first responder efforts. If you join a CERT, you will receive basic-level training in Emergency Preparedness, Disaster Medical Operations, Fire Suppression, Light Search and Rescue Operations, Incident Command System, Disaster Psychology, Terrorism Awareness and Community Animal Response Team. Total training is usually about 20 hours, scheduled in 2-4 hour modules, over a period of weeks. Training courses, student materials and equipment are provided free of charge. Fair Lawn CERT is always looking for new members to assist in the community. ### Construction Material Collection

The Borough garbage contractor will be collecting small amounts of construction material at the curb during the weeks of May 6<sup>th</sup> and October 21<sup>st</sup> on the regular garbage day. Quantities are limited to four (4) thirty-two gallon barrels not weighing more than 50 pounds each. Excess quantities will not be collected. Materials must be contained or tied for ease of handling by the collection crew. Construction includes building wood, paneling, sheet rock, tiles, toilets, sinks, doors, windows, cabinetry, countertops and garage doors. Construction does NOT include any recyclables (including metal), hazardous materials, paints, brick, block, stone, concrete, asphalt, stone, rocks and dirt. These items will not be collected.

**IMPORTANT REMINDER:** Please ensure that you and your immediate family know where your discharge papers are. The importance of this is imperative. Unfortunately, many Veterans or family members look to locate discharge papers when they are met with a dire or tragic situation. Please give a copy to those individuals that have been designated to make decisions for you (spouse, children, power of attorney, etc...).

**New Jersey Motor Vehicle Veterans Recognition:** The New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (NJ MVC) offers numerous recognitions for Veterans that reside in the State of New Jersey. As of July 2016, the NJ MVC offers a "Veteran Designation" on Veteran's valid New Jersey driver's license or non-driver ID card. Veterans must present a copy of their discharge paper with their valid driver's license or non-driver ID card at any NJ MVC office for a temporary sticker. For renewal driver licenses or non-driver ID cards, Veterans must also follow the standard renewal procedures and provide the appropriate documents.

Effective this year, disabled Veterans and Purple Heart recipients can obtain a special placard which will exempt them from paying municipal meter fees for up to 24 hours. Those Veterans that meet these qualifications can apply for the placard at any NJ MVC office.

**Bergen County Veterans Identification Card:** The Bergen County Clerk's Office, located at 1 Bergen County Plaza in Hackensack, offers photo Veteran Service Identification Cards to all honorably discharged Bergen County Veterans.
